Terms and Conditions for a Green Valley Journal

1. Submission and Acceptance

- **Eligibility for Submission**: Authors must ensure that their submission adheres to the Green Valley journal 's scope and submission guidelines.
- **Originality**: The submission must be original work and should not have been published or under consideration elsewhere.
- **Peer Review**: Submissions will undergo peer review by experts in the field. Authors may be required to revise their work based on reviewer feedback.

- Open Access: Green Valley journal require open access or allow authors to choose open access for their articles. Terms related to open access (e.g., article processing charges or licensing) will be specified.

3. Ethical Guidelines
